Inspiring Wonders of the Island

Spend an idyllic afternoon exploring Bermuda's natural beauty and learning about wildlife. Your experience begins with a sightseeing drive, enhanced by your driver's local knowledge. Then, open yourself to encounters with the wonders of the animal kingdom, during a stop at Bermuda Aquarium, Museum & Zoo, where the mission is to inspire appreciation and care of island environments. Discover more than 200 species of fish and delicate marine invertebrates that thrive in shallow coastal waters. Be dazzled by displays of over 300 birds like chattering cockatoos and pink flamingos. Glimpse colorful Madagascar reptiles and meet mammals from oceanic islands, all housed in lush naturalistic exhibits that evoke your curiosity. Then, relax amidst the enchantment of picturesque bays and pretty pastel Bermuda houses dotting verdant hillsides during a drive around Harrington Sound. Your journey of wonder continues at Crystal Caves of Bermuda—one of the island's largest and most dramatic cave systems. Descend 81 steps into the caves and experience breathtaking views. Immersed amongst mysterious crystalized stalactites, gaze at the caves' astounding deep azure lakes, then follow the same steps for your ascent out of the caves. The scenic return drive along the Great Sound is a perfect moment to reflect on all you've experienced.





caribbean & central america Essential, Enchanting Bermuda

Fall in love with Bermuda as you visit many of its most compelling attributes during this half-day driving tour through the island. Your driver will pick you up at Royal Naval Dockyard and take you into picturesque Somerset Village-with a pass over Somerset Drawbridge, the smallest drawbridge in the world. Have your camera to hand at Gibbs Hill Lighthouse and its enthralling, 360-degree view. Be ready for occasional photo stops while Bermuda's beauty captivates you during a coastal South Shore drive where you'll glimpse the island's beloved pink-sand beaches, azure waters and, on a clear day, the imposing barrier reef that encircles the island. This drive also takes you past Bermuda Botanical Gardens, a lush, 14.5hectare (36-acre) haven for flowers, shrubs, and trees, and then to another photo stop at John Smith's Bay whilst en route to what UNESCO calls "The Historic Town of St George and Related Fortifications"-known commonly as St George's. In this earliest example of an English urban settlement in the New World, take time on your own to wander the town's quaint brick streets and admire its Colonial architecture, popping into irresistible shops along the way, or even posing for a photo on the Stocks, aside the Ducking Stool, or on the steps of Their Majesties Chappell, St. Peter's Church—the oldest Anglican church in continuous use outside the British Isles. Your route through the best of Bermuda continues with a stunning drive along the North Shore, with enchanting coastal views and glimpses of more pastel homes dotting the landscape, to Hamilton, Bermuda's capital and cosmopolitan centre. There, enjoy free time to meander fascinating Front Street, with art, high-end shops, and mouthwatering eateries all beckoning for your attention. From this life-and-soul-ofthe-island hotspot, your return drive to Royal Naval Dockyard takes you along Middle Road, with gorgeous views of Great Sound to cap off your day on an enchanted island.
