

Prepare to be dazzled by rows of colourful embroidery, beadwork, and handwoven textiles at the lively town market whilst the nutty fragrance and rich flavour of local coffee pairs perfectly with some of the most exquisite chocolate in the world.





DAY **5** Rich Reefs and Garifuna Culture in Roatán

Submerged beneath Caribbean waves, the Bonacca Ridge mountains peek above the surface to form spellbinding Roatán and her Bay Island siblings. Bejewelled reefs and an anthology of marine life beckon snorkellers and scuba divers to the pristine underwater world, where rainbow coral and whale sharks cruise the currents. Colourful Garifuna culture blooms in energetic dance and traditional food, while island spirit is bottled at the Roatan Rum Company. Go fast or slow with hiking and fishing trips, paddle boarding or glass-bottomed boat rides. Tune into the tropics in mangrove forests and jungle eco-parks, where sleepy sloths slumber and bright-feathered macaws screech through the branches or pad across silky soft sands on the finest beaches in Central America.







Blue Harbor Tropical Arboretum Hike and Starfish Beach Club

Drive through dense countryside to Blue Harbor Tropical Arboretum, where colourful exotic flora abound and the air carries joyful birdsong.
